

**OFFICIAL MINUTES OF

November 17, 2021

The meeting was called to order by Ms. Roberta Hoag President Hoag made the following announcement: The notice requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey have been satisfied by the inclusion of the date, time, and place of this regular meeting in the annual schedule and notice of regular meetings is posted at Borough Hall, was emailed to the Star Ledger and The Record and was filed with the Borough Clerk of the Borough of November 8, 2021.

Report from County Health Inspector, Elizabeth Czekanski: September 2021, A dog bit, the animal had up to date rabies and license. He was quarantined for 45 days. Emergency response to Alpine Country Club due to storm Ida. Kitchen was destroyed, no food preparation, Alpine Country Club will send blueprints of new construction and will call the County when repairs are made. Mosquito Control was sprayed the Lenox Avenue section of the Borough for complaints of Mosquito's after storm Ida. DPW was referred to a Lenox Ave property for drain blockage. Restaurants in the Borough were inspected and received satisfactory. Schools received satisfactory upon inspection. October, Ambulance Corp held a temporary event, received satisfactory upon inspection. Dog bite, the animal was quarantined for 45 days because it came from overseas. 2<sup>nd</sup> Dog bite, observation by the County will be done. An establishment in town plead guilty to prior offense, fine was paid. November, County Road School, small kitchen renovation, kitchen is not commercial and still providing lunch in prepared, pre-package meals.

Minutes: May minutes, 1<sup>st</sup> motion to approve Nisha Gandhi 2<sup>nd</sup> Ilana Mitiliski. September minutes will be voted on in the next meeting.

Board of Health Secretary reported that the 2022 Animal licenses have been delivered. Letters to pet owners are being mailed December 1, 2021, to remind them that pet licenses are to be renewed January 1, 2022- March 1, 2022.

Old Business: The Borough is looking into sharing services with other towns for the Rabies Clinic. Covid, numbers have come down, 5-year-old and up have gotten approved for the Covid-19 vaccination, The booster is recommended for anyone who received their vaccination 6 or more months ago. The library has resumed chair Yoga, and every 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday health consults are being offered at the Train Station. Fee schedule hasn't been updated, the motion to increase the fees were opposed. Dates for 2022 BOH Meetings will be held on 1/20/2022, 5/18,2022, 9/21/2022, and 11/16/2022 at 7:00pm unless otherwise notified.

New Business: Subdivision 11 Central Ave and 48 Meadow Street approved. BBP contract received and renewed.
